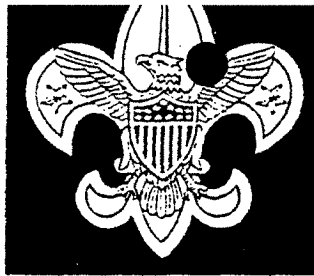

Dear Paul:

In follow-up to our recent phone conversation I am submitting the following account of the severing of Richard Burkhardt from Scouting participation.

In the letters submitted to you in June, the reasons stated are those of homosexual acts performed by Mr. Burkhardt.

On Thursday, June 16th, I met with [REDACTED] for 2 hours and discussed at great length the entire episode. The [REDACTED] family believe in, and have been active in, Scouting for a number of years. They were concerned 1) about their son's experience (for which they have sought spiritual and professional help) and 2) about adverse publicity to Scouting should they press charges against Richard Burkhardt. After weighing the pros and cons, the [REDACTED] said they would be satisfied if Mr. Burkhardt would sever all Scouting ties so that this same type of activity could not happen with other Scouts. However, if he would not leave Scouting they were prepared and ready to press charges.

I contacted our counsel, Richard W. Kiefer, Esq., and sought his advice on approaching Mr. Burkhardt. As a result of Mr. Kiefer's advice Mr. Burkhardt was called and an appointment made for the following morning between the District Executive, the District Chairman and Vice Chairman and Mr. Burkhardt. Everyone showed for the meeting including Mr. Burkhardt's wife and child.

The Scouting representative asked Mr. Burkhardt to sever his Scouting association and to return his registration card. At that time none of the Scouting representatives were specific about the reason they were asking for his resignation. They said they were doing it upon authority of the Executive Board and the council office and that if he wanted further explanation he should contact

Ron Rogers at the Council Service Center. At this time both Mr. and Mrs. Burkhardt ripped up their registration cards, threw them on the table, and left.

Mr. Burkhardt went home and immediately called me at the office. (I think it should be pointed out that Richard Burkhardt and I had worked together on Council activities so that he was not calling a stranger.) He asked me specifically why he was asked to leave Scouting. I told him that he had been accused of homosexual acts and that we had letters from the persons describing these acts.


His response was in the following order:

R. Burkhardt - "Ron, is there legal action pending?"
Ron Rogers - "At present no, however the parents are prepared to file charges if you remain in Scouting."
R. Burkhardt - "You mean if I leave, they will not press charges?"
Ron Rogers - "That is correct."
R. Burkhardt - "Well, Ron, with God and my wife as witnesses I am not guilty, but for my love of Scouting I will leave."

It should be noted that the community where this occurred is very small and everyone knows each other's business. We felt it would not serve any purpose other than start a rumor-mill to approach the other boys mentioned in the letter, who by the way, have dropped out of the program.

I hope this information will be helpful in this matter.

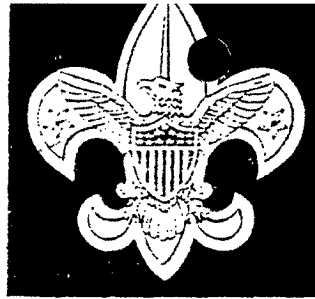

On April 17, 1983 while setting up for Carroll Wee Out at Camp Huskwa, Richard Burkhard confronted me with the question of "if somebody would come up and offer you blow job would you let them do it?" I said no. Later in the day he changed the question by putting his name in there. I still said no, then when everybody went to take wood cuts we stayed to look for more wood. He then asked me again and I still said no. Then he said just try it if you don't like it we will stop. I said no. But then I thought what he might be able to do in the future in my scouting career. After while with all these thoughts he finally persuaded me to let him give me oral sex but against my morals. After words he said that would be it. Unless I went to him.

Then on June 14, 1983 after an OA meeting. He offered to give me a ride to the playground. I didn't suspect anything but he ask me again I said, "I was not in the mood for it." He then said, "maybe at our OA chapter ordeal in August?" I said

As the parents of Eagle Scout, [REDACTED], we were floored, that one son was imposed upon by a homosexual act by one Richard Burkhard and my husband. I wanted to take action immediately. To have a man of this caliber, working with our youth in scouting, and in a leadership capacity, is without saying, a total disgrace! My husband and I are concerned for [REDACTED] and all the many other boys who may be influenced by this — — individual, and he must be stopped! My husband and I have been in scouting many many years and we know that Boy Scouts of America do not condone this kind of corruption! We certainly expect action to be taken to prevent the influencing of any more of our boys in the scouting family. Our first reaction was to take this to a Court of law, but we fear the retaliation that could be harmful to us possibly by him, Richard Burkhard. However, knowing that the Boy Scouts of America will not tolerate this kind of impudence, we can feel relieved knowing you will take the necessary steps needed to expel him from our youth organizations!
