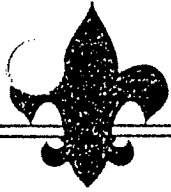

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




In thinking over the letter you referred to me from Registration Service, I realize I may not have been specific enough. Here are the details of the [REDACTED].

With [REDACTED]

At 8 or 9 troop meetings, beginning in November or December 1982, and continuing through February or March 1984, [REDACTED] would call [REDACTED] outside, or would have him outside for some activity, and picked him up, kissed him on the cheek or forehead, said "I love you," and placed his hand on [REDACTED] genitals. This would continue until [REDACTED] could get down and get away. Sometimes he asked [REDACTED] to go for a walk with him.

After a troop meeting in the summer of 1983, he gave [REDACTED] a ride presumably home, instead he drove out [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had [REDACTED] in his lap and steer, and placed his hand on [REDACTED] genitals; until [REDACTED] to be driven home. When he had [REDACTED] the car he would pick him up and growl.

He took [REDACTED] with him to his work ^{spring} [REDACTED] 1983, and twice asked [REDACTED] to sit on his lap and touched [REDACTED] genitals.

3 or 4 times in the spring of 1984 he telephoned [REDACTED] inviting him to go camping alone with him.

With [REDACTED] during the winter camp in December 1982, he invited [REDACTED] to sleep in his tent, and put his hand inside [REDACTED] underwear and touched [REDACTED] list. [REDACTED] moved and changed the subject, and when [REDACTED] into the tent, they all slept.

When these facts came to light, I interviewed every Scout [REDACTED] who had been

I found that the stories these four told me agreed in all significant details with the stories [REDACTED] told me. I am therefore certain that these are the true facts.

These incidents came to my attention on April 12, 1984, when [REDACTED] called me.

That evening I talked with [REDACTED] and with [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] I talked with various Scouts April 13, and at winter camp April 14 and 15. April 16 I contacted you, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] ment. I continued to talk to various Scouts, and had [REDACTED] interviewed all who were in the troop when M [REDACTED] active by about two weeks later.

Mr [REDACTED] had taken a leave of absence in February 1984 because he was being transferred to night work. He returned to a troop meeting on May 15, when I took him outside, told him the facts I had, and asked for his resignation. He wrote out a resignation, while protesting his innocence and that he was being misunderstood. The troop committee on May 31 accepted his resignation and requested you to remove his name from our roster, and as a merit badge counselor.

I hope this is what you need.

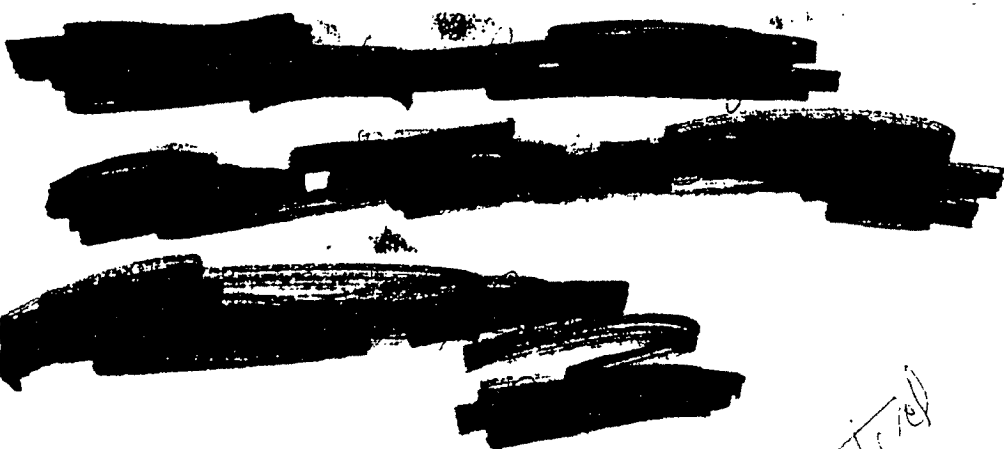

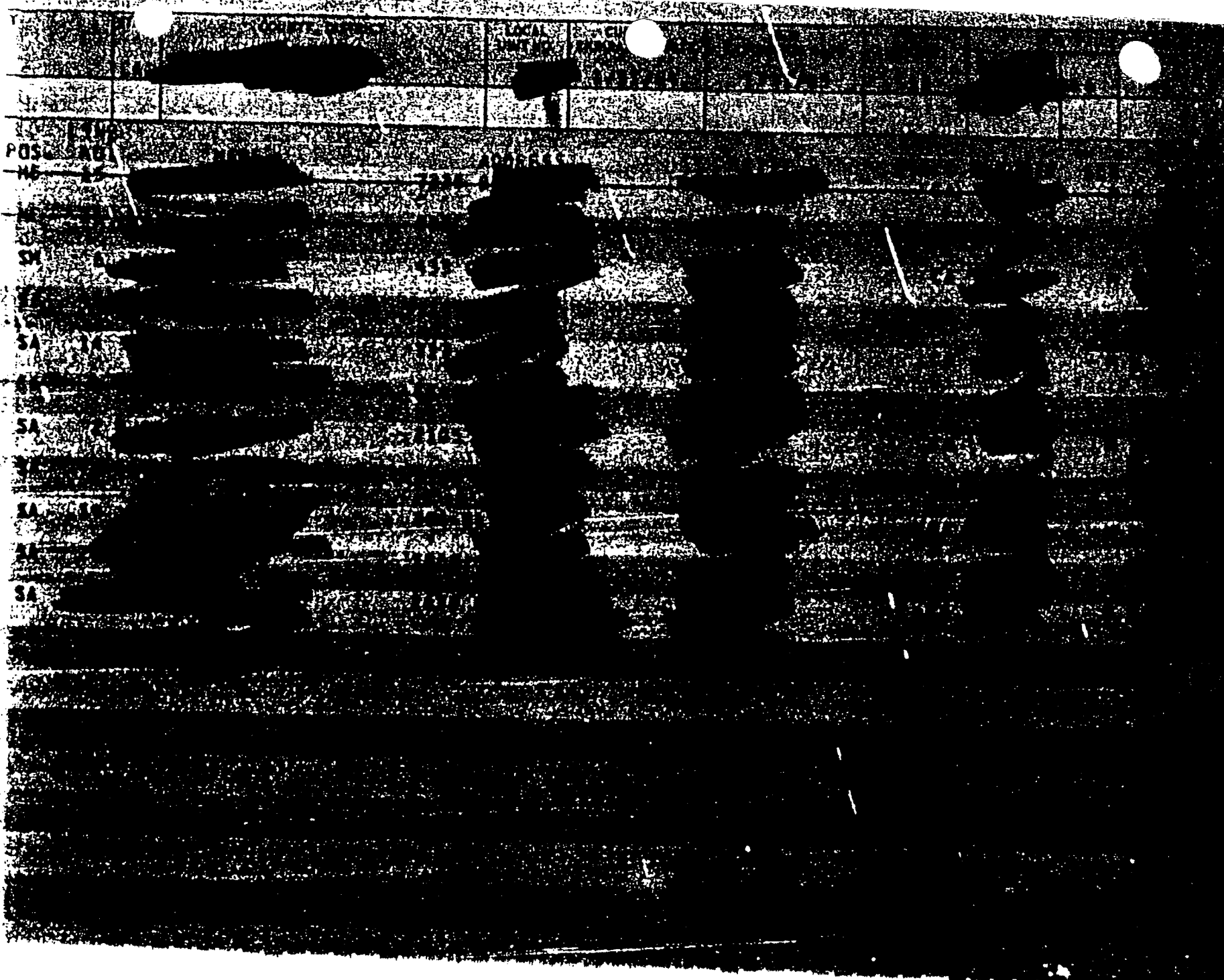
