
Dear Mr. Ernst:

BACKGROUND: On thursday, August 15, 1985, it was reported to me by District Executive Clifford Nolan that [REDACTED] in the city of Margate, FL in the Lighthouse District had informed him that Scouter Gary Nolan had allegedly molested one or two of the members of his Troop and was being investigated by one of the local Police departments in the area. Gary Nolan was registered as an assistant Scoutmaster of Troop 118 in the town of Davie, FL in the New River District. He had also been active in our Order of the Arrow lodge.

After checking with local law enforcement agencies, we determined that the investigation was indeed being conducted by the Davie Police Department and was assigned to Detective Linda Deckinger.

ACTION:1. DISCUSSION WITH SCOUTMASTER

On Thursday, August 15, I spoke with [REDACTED] over the telephone and he informed me that one of the boys' parents had approached him with concern that her son had befriended Gary Nolan and that they were going many places together. [REDACTED] stated that he had no idea where the boy had met Gary Nolan, but presumes that it was at a Camporee or at an Order of the Arrow event. He also stated that Gary Nolan was not active with his Troop and that he had never seen them together.

2. DISCUSSION WITH DETECTIVE

On Friday, August 16, 1985, I met with Detective Linda Deckinger at the Davie Police Department to discuss the investigation of Gary Nolan. She informed me that Gary was indeed being investigated and that an arrest was pending. She stated that the alleged victim's parents had filed a complaint and that testimony from the boy revealed that another boy, who had since moved to New York, had also been involved with Gary. The testimony from both boys revealed that Gary Nolan had molested both of them on numerous occasions. At least one of the acts had taken place at a council camp, but most others took place at Gary Nolan's home. The testimony of the two boys, she felt, was enough to arrest Gary on several counts of sexual battery and several counts of lewd and lascivious behavior. She said she felt that he would be arrested no later than Tuesday, August 20.

Detective Deckinger also stated that she had spoken with [REDACTED] and that he had given her basically the same information he had reported to me.

She also reported to me that she had interrogated Gary Nolan and that he neither admitted nor denied the charges, but that his attorney had told her that if the investigation warranted an arrest, Gary would turn himself in with no incident.

3. LETTER REVOKING B.S.A. REGISTRATION

After gathering information from Detective Deckinger, a certified letter was sent to Mr. Gary Nolan revoking his registration in the Boy Scouts of America. That letter was sent on Friday, August 16, 1985, and we received a signed receipt dated August 22, 1985.

4. FOLLOW-UP

On Wednesday, August 28, 1985, I placed a telephone call to Detective Deckinger and she informed me that on Thursday, August 22, 1985, Gary Nolan was arrested on charges of sexual battery and indecent assault upon a minor. She stated that he would be charged on numerous counts of both of the charges but that it would be up to the District Attorney to determine exactly how many. She said that he was given a \$10,000 bond and that she believed that he had posted the required 10% or \$1,000. She further stated that the filing date would be September 3, 1985, and that she could not say when the trial would begin, but that she was sure the case would come to trial.
