This letter at your request, is an account of what happened to my son at Tomahawk Camp during the week of July 1, 1972 to July 8, 1972. On Sunday July 2, 1972 after a days activities my son [REDACTED] was approached by (David Beardsley) who asked him how the days events went. After talking for a time he requested they go into the tent and talk some more. He talked about requirements for being an Eagle Scout and then he grabbed my son by the arm and pulled him down on the cot and put his hand into my sons sexual organs beneath his clothing. My son was terrified and speechless and Mr. Beardsley

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continued talking and molesting for approximately 5 min. Then he left the tent. On

Mon. The 3<sup>d</sup>, he again came to camp and talked to the boys about the days events. He took my son into the tent and repeated the same process as the previous night. My son tent-mate [REDACTED] was in his cot

and witnessed the actions taking place.

After the incident my son told [REDACTED] what took place and

on Tues. Mr. Beardsley came back and held my son by the hand-

but [REDACTED] intervened so nothing happened that night. Mr. Beardsley did not come back to camp after

Tues. July 3, 1972. My son related the events to me on July 10, 1972 and I took action as deemed necessary from that point.
