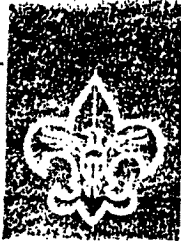

## Scout official is arrested

An official of the Boy Scouts of America was arrested in a Phoenix book store on a morals charge, police reported Saturday.

Edgar Tally, 49, 2251 E. Palmaro, finance director for the Theodore Roosevelt Council of the Boy Scouts of America, was arrested Friday night at Uncle Ted's Bookstore, 1816 E. McDowell, officers said.

Tally was booked into Maricopa County Jail for investigation of lewd and lascivious acts and later released on \$200 bail, jail officials said.

Information concerning a preliminary hearing in the case was not available.
