Our son, [REDACTED] a member of Troop 239, told his mother and me that his scoutmaster, James Easley, had been, for about a year, having indecent sex acts with him.

When questioned as to more details, he said -- "He got me to 'beat him off' and made bets to the effect that he could 'beat off' more times than I could."

I had suspected something strange for sometime. Each camping trip, and the week at Camp Old Indian, [REDACTED] was always sharing a tent or cabin with James Easley, instead of other boys. Also, the interest he showed to [REDACTED] seemed more than that shown to other boys in the troop.

The thing that brought this out was a phone conversation [REDACTED] had with James Easley on August 11, 1975. [REDACTED] part of the conversation was very evasive with a lot of "Um-huh, yes, no, like got to go now, I don't know, maybe", etc. After he hung up,

all this has upset us very much. we thought that James Esley was a good scoutmaster, and had hoped our suspicions about him were wrong. However, we feel, as you probably do, that he is sick and definitely has no place around young boys. we can only hope that this has no lasting harm to our son.
