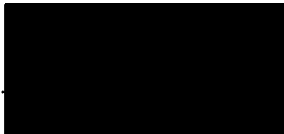

went on a campout with Donald Davis  
and a patrol of Scouts from troop 770  
in Decatur, Texas. On Saturday morning  
I woke up to find Donald Davis in  
another tent with 11 year old [REDACTED]

him. Later that day Donald Davis,  
[REDACTED] and I were talking  
when [REDACTED] asked off I knew what  
molluscate meant. Before I could  
answer Donald Davis told him to  
shut up.

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On June 21, 1975, I was told by my son [redacted] that Gerald Davis had on one occasion told him wild sex stories about his + some girls in Guam. He also told him that when they returned from his camping trip he would let him look at the Playboy magazine he had at his apartment.

Also, while on two separate camping trips, Gerald Davis masturbated in front of my son [redacted] + [redacted] tried to get [redacted] to put his hands on his penis he recalled a dinner on both occasions.

Learning of this I called Gerald Davis at his apartment + told him what I had just learned. He admitted to everything + said that if he would not press charges he would drop out of Scouting + seek medical help.

I informed Dr. John Halberg, Troop 770 Scoutmaster, of this on June 21, 1975.

On June 24, 1975, I notified Allen Strube of the situation because I had just learned that Gerald Davis had not dropped out of Scouting + was on a summer camp trip with Troop 773.

The above statement is true to the best of my knowledge. [redacted]



Aug. 28, 1978

On approx. June 24th [REDACTED] called me stating that Gerald Davis had been having unnatural sex acts with his 11 year old son [REDACTED] he stated this had happened three different times.

I contacted Ted Bedsoh who contacted Steve Myers, Steve Myers and myself talked with Father Moran who stated he knew of the problem and would go to summer camp the next day to see about getting Gerald to come home; Gerald Davis did come home from summer camp, I talked to Gerald Davis and he did admit that the incident had happened.

The unnatural sex acts were masturbation. [REDACTED]
