Dear Paul:

On the morning of December 8, 1976, at approximately 9:30 a.m. and accompanied by Mr. Gene Buie, District Chairman, District #9, Longhorn Council, I called on Mr. Kenneth R. Lynch.

Mr. Lynch was nervous, due to his not being acquainted with Mr. Buie or myself. After handshakes and greetings, Mr. Buie presented Mr. Lynch with a letter from Mr. Lloyd Flood, Council President, directing Mr. Lynch to sever any and all relations with the Boy Scouts of America.

Following Mr. Lynch's reading the letter, he stated that he had expected some action from B.S.A.

Mr. Buie stated that he was sorry, but we maintain a set of principles and requirements for leadership that do not allow any and everyone to be associated with Scouting, and explained to Mr. Lynch that if and when his circumstances change, he could request a review of this decision.

Mr. Lynch stated that he understood and would abide by the directions set forth in the letter. He further stated that his circumstances were improving and he had fun while it lasted.

Mr. Buie and I departed at approximately 9:40 a.m. and returned to the Scout Service Center.

In accordance with the authority conferred by the Adult Probation and Parole Law of the State of Texas, you have been placed on Probation on this date 10-18-74, for a period of 10 years, by the Honorable Barbara Gray, Judge Criminal District Court No. 4, Tarrant County, Texas.

It is the ORDER of the Court that you shall comply with the following terms and conditions of Probation:

- a. Commit no offense against the laws of this State or any other State or the United States;
- b. Avoid injurious or vicious habits;
- c. Avoid persons and places of disreputable or harmful character;
- d. Report to the Adult Probation Officer of Tarrant County, Texas, as directed: on the 18th day of November, 1974, and on the 18th day of each month thereafter, during Probation;
- e. Permit the Probation Officer to visit you at your home or elsewhere;
- f. Work faithfully at suitable employment as far as possible;
- g. Remain within the limits of Tarrant County, Texas, unless given permission by the Tarrant County Adult Probation Officer to leave therefrom;
- h. (1) Pay your fine, if one be assessed, and pay all court costs whether a fine be assessed or not, in one or several sums, as follows:
Court cost of \$50.00 to be paid @ \$5.00 per month
(2) Make restitution to and through the Adult Probation Officer of Tarrant County, Texas, in the amount of \$ _____, at the rate of _____ per _____: the first payment to be made on the _____ day of _____, 19____, and a like payment on the _____ day of each month thereafter until full restitution is made.
- i. Support your dependents;
- j. Notify the Adult Probation Officer of Tarrant County, Texas, if your address or employment is changed, within three days from the date of the change.
- k. Pay a Probation Fee to and through the Adult Probation Office, Tarrant County, Texas, in the amount of \$ 5.00, on the 18th day of November, 1974, and on the 18th day of each month thereafter during Probation;

Report to psychiatrist and receive treatment until discharged.

You are advised that under the laws of this State, the Court has determined the above terms and conditions of your Probation, and may at any time during the period of Probation, alter or modify them. The Court also has the authority, at any time during the period of Probation, to Revoke your Probation for any violation of the conditions of your Probation set out above.

The Court has placed you on Probation, believing that if you sincerely try to obey and live up to the conditions of your Probation, your attitude and conduct will improve to the benefit of the public and yourself.
