The Boy Scouts of America maintains that no boy can grow into the best kind of citizen without recognizing his obligation to God. In the first part of the Scout Oath or Promise the boy declares, "On my honor I will do my best to do my duty to God and my country and to obey the Law." The recognition of God as the ruling and leading power in the universe and the grateful acknowledgement of His favors and blessings are necessary to the best type of citizenship and wholesome precepts in the education of the growing boy. No matter what the religious faith of a boy may be, this fundamental need of good citizenship should be kept before him. The Boy Scouts of America therefore recognizes the religious element in the training of the boy, but is absolutely nonsectarian in its attitude toward that religious training. Its policy is that the organization or institution with which the Scout is connected shall give definite attention to his religious life.

Only persons willing to subscribe to this declaration of principle shall be entitled to a certificate of leadership in carrying out the Scout program--Bylaws, Boy Scouts of America, Article II, Section 2, Clause 1.
