

On September 17, 1980, [REDACTED] received a phone call from [REDACTED], (a widow with two sons in [REDACTED]). She read him a letter that her son [REDACTED]. Mr. Mangle asked me to follow up on this situation. (the letter is attached)

I called Mrs. [REDACTED] that afternoon and asked if I could see the letter Friday morning. She said her other son, [REDACTED] would get a copy of the letter for our records. On Friday, September 19th, 1980, I met with [REDACTED] (the older brother) he filled me in on more facts.

It seems [REDACTED] had been at the Order of the Arrow Ordeal the weekend before, [REDACTED] deal of the time. [REDACTED] got [REDACTED] showed him a pistol (not loaded, but he had ammo), suggested that [REDACTED] take a shower with him. Fortunately, a leader came in and this made it easier for [REDACTED] leave. [REDACTED] a blood brother (the exact procedure was not known), [REDACTED] put him off.
