

Mert Matthewson, our District Executive for the county involved, has been able to secure the following information. This information is from the court records. It has not been publicized and the sheriff's office would not put anything in writing, but it is fact from the records on April 17, 1981. ~~Michael S. Mauch~~ ~~pled~~ guilty to statutory rape in the second degree and indecent liberties. He was placed on bail but that was revoked when he tried to make contact with the youth involved. He was then sent to Western Washington State Hospital for observation on October 20, 1981. It was determined that he definitely meets the criteria of a sexual psychopath and was committed to Western Washington State Hospital for 90 days.
