This letter is to officially notify you that Mr. Cary Butler, Route 2, Mineola, Texas, is unfit to be registered with the Boy Scouts of America. He is currently registered with Post 389 of Mineola, Texas. We have removed him from his position with this unit as well as all rolls of the East Texas Area Council. We ask you to remove his name in every way where it might appear with the National Council, Boy Scouts of America.

The reason that Mr. Cary Butler is an desirable person to be affiliated with the Boy Scouts of America is that it has been proved beyond a shadow of a doubt that he has practiced Sodomy in several instances. Fortunately, the experiences were not with members of the Boy Scouts of America. They were with individuals who were not registered in any way with the Boy Scout Movement.

Before this discovery was made, Mr. Butler was a respected citizen of Mineola, Texas, having taught schools in the public school system for six years. He was a student counselor at the high school. After this discovery was made, he was dismissed as an employee of the school system, and I do not know exactly where he lives at this time.

So that you might have identification features about Mr. Butler, in case he tries to register with the Boy Scouts of America in the future, I will give you what I know about him. He was born and raised at Lufkin, Texas. He is Caucasian, married, has one child, a boy, at the present time. His wife's name is Mary. He has brown hair and is approximately 5' 6" tall. His weight is about 135 pounds.
