This is a statement voluntarily made by Mr. [REDACTED] in his capacity as Principal of the Anderson Valley Junior-Senior High School:

On or about 28 April 1969 at about 1000 hours I received a report that an adult in a blue station wagon had approached the school grounds and had picked up at least two students and possibly three. I immediately cross checked the information from teachers and students, made an on the spot investigation and then reported it directly to the sheriff's office in Boonville on Highway 128.

The information that I was able to glean indicated that an adult by the name of "Bill" was the party concerned in the pick up of these 13 and 14 year old girls. Further investigation indicated that these young people had gotten together with this adult and gone to the Frank Jones residence on Highway 128 in Philo and later went to Henry Woods. An investigation revealed that the party connected with the pick up was William Elton. May I state that the pick up was surreptitiously done, that Mr. Elton did not at any time clear with the office or at any time have the permission of the parents or guardians of these girls.

At a later date Mr. Elton contacted my office by phone requesting a definition of charges against him and also requested that I not levy any charges against him. He further indicated that if charges were levied that I would have a most difficult time. The call was monitored by Mr. Roland Guthers, a teacher on my staff.

All actions taken, reports, suspensions, etc., were done in my capacity as Principal of Anderson Valley Junior-Senior High School.

I have read page 1 and 2 of this 2 page report (statement) and to the best of my knowledge is a true and accurate statement.

for 'contributing'**

William Francis Elton, 26, Philo, was arrested early today on four counts of contributing to the delinquency of a minor.

Sheriff's deputies found three minors at the Elton residence today as they were coming to arrest the suspect on a previous complaint.

The three, all runaway juveniles, were detained by juvenile authorities while Elton was arrested and placed in county jail on the additional three counts.

A quantity of unknown drugs were found at the time of arrest, but further charges are dependent on the analysis of these items.
