The information you provided will enable us to identify these individuals should they ever again attempt to register in the Scouting program.

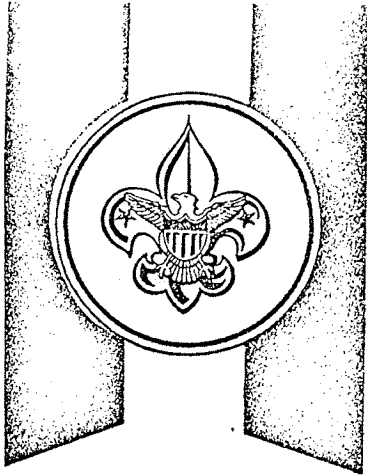

I assume this is sufficient information. This is a sordid situation. All three were involved in "the Group".

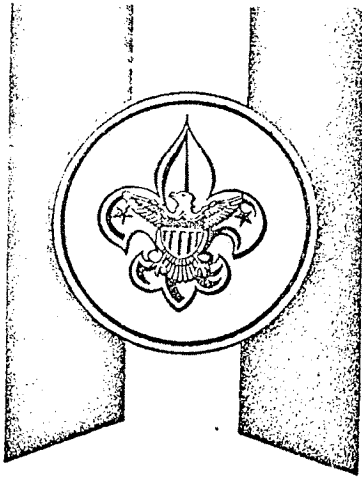
