Dear Roger:

Back in December of 1966 you sent us the case of one Harold Arnold Jones and asked that he be placed on the confidential file for a conviction in 1963 for "orally copulating a fourteen year old boy."

By accident, one of our alert girls today discovered that Jones is currently registered as a Committeeman in Pack 3132. The problem seems to be that he was sent to us from your office as a Re Scouter. This, of course, was not true, or at least it should not have been true. But the fact that he was sent as a Re meant that we did not check him against our confidential file. As you know, we check only New, SR and Transfer Scouters against our confidential names, so this man got through because he was listed as Re.

Maybe you should speak to your girls about being as careful as possible that when they list somebody as Re that they are in reality registering in the same position in the same unit as they were last year.

Now that we have discovered Jones' registration and since the unit has a March 1969 expiration, I suspect we probably shouldn't take any drastic action, but when the unit reregisters in March, let's all of us do our best to make certain that Jones is not reregistered.

Subject: Confidential report on Harold Arnold Jones

We've just received a report on Harold Arnold Jones of 2632 Rheem Ave., Richmond, California, who on January 28, 1963, pleaded guilty to 288A and given five years probation. This was terminated in early August, 1966. On November 14, 1962, a mentally ill petition was filed. He was arrested for an offense "orally copulating". He was put in the Martinez jail for 3 or 4 months and given 5 years probation (plus fined) and instructed to take psychiatric treatments.

A close relative of the individual contacted us when she found after his probation period he had been assigned as Assistant Cubmaster of Pack 132 in District No. 7 of our Council. The unit charter expires 3-67. He registered in September, 1966. Attached hereto find a separation notice.
