Dear Mr. Hyman:

Please be advised that I represent Mr. Lincoln Thomson.

Mr. Thomson was employed as a camp counsellor at the summer camp run by the APAC. As a result of a misunderstanding, Mr. Thomson has been asked to resign his post as Scout Director after 17 years.

Mr. Thomson has been told that this is because of something that happened while at camp. However, he has been informed only that it is because of information that has come to your attention. He would like to meet any accusers, face to face, and would request that you arrange a meeting with any parties preferring charges or making any complaints against him.

As the result of information released concerning him, Mr. Thomson has been almost released as a Scout Director after 17 years of volunteer and faithful service.

To Mr. Thomson this is a very serious matter and he sincerely requests that you make arrangements for him to know what took place last summer that has created this situation and two, if persons have made complaints against him, he would like to face his accusers, face to face and discuss it in the presence of Scout officers and yourself, so that this misunderstanding can be cleared up. Mr. Thomson feels that his reputation is at stake, but feels that this matter can be cleared up before yourself and a representative of the Boys Scouts of Boston.
