
I checked into the "incriminating evidence" reported by the Troop 352 Committee per your request. What actually happened here is that the Committee interviewed boys in the unit and ascertained from these interviews, evidence of perverted sexual activity. The Committee then, as a group, confronted Mr. Kalasky, who broke down and admitted to the Committee group (the same group that signed the letter) that he was a homosexual and did in fact carry on these activities with Scouts in the troop.

The Committee is most vigorous in their desire that there not be any further involvement of the boys of the troop, because of the disturbance it would create. They are most hopeful that their signed statement would suffice. They did not get a signed statement admitting to these things from Mr. Kalasky, and they realize now this was an error. We could have brought that about, but we didn't know of the situation until after all of these steps had been taken.

I am not sure how much further we would want to pursue this and I seek your advice and guidance.

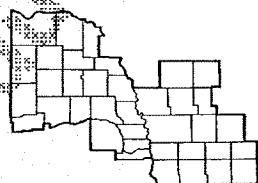

Thank you for your letter of January 21 and the information you forwarded concerning James E. Kalasky, currently registered as Scoutmaster of Troop 352 in Omaha. We have placed this information in our files and have taken steps to have his name deleted from the Troop roster.

The identification particulars you provided on the record sheet are most complete. However, since the letter signed by the Committee members of Troop 352 indicates they have obtained incriminating evidence to support the charges against Mr. Kalasky, we would be most appreciative if you could forward this information to us. This would be very important in strengthening our position of refusing to accept any future registration we might receive from this individual.

I am sure you realize that this leaves Troop 352 without any registered unit leader. Undoubtedly, someone is taking over in this position. In order for the unit to continue to receive program inserts in Scouting Magazine, it will be necessary to advise this office of the name of the new unit leader. This should be done by filing with us an additional enrollment for this individual in his new position. Please do not file a separation notice as we have already dropped the current leader.



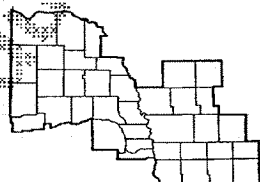
