We sincerely hope that your council's law suit is successfully defended and we would appreciate your keeping us advised of the latest developments regarding this situation.

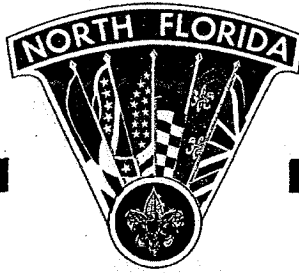

Curtis A. Kelly was a member of our Camp Staff at the Baden-Powell Scout Reservation last summer. The incident occurred at Camp and was witnessed by another boy. A warrant was issued for Kelly and he appeared before a Judge in Palatka, Florida and was bound over to the next session of the Circuit Court. He was released on bond and since that time we have heard of two other similar incidents. We are now being sued for \$20,000 by the parents of the victim at Camp and the suit is being defended by Attorneys acting for the INA Insurance Company. Up to the present time nothing has appeared in the newspapers concerning this incident. We will try to keep you informed about this matter as it develops.

Thank you for the confidential record sheets you recently sent to us concerning Curtis A. Kelly, formerly registered as a Jr. Assistant Scoutmaster in Troop 297, and Carl Edward Van Horn, formerly registered as Assistant Scoutmaster in Troop 51. Thanks also for the copies of Van Horn's criminal court records. We have placed all this information in our files.

Although our records for Mr. Van Horn are complete, we wonder if it would be possible for you to provide us with more detailed information regarding the incidences of sodomy against Mr. Kelly involving Scouts. We would very much appreciate your writing us a detailed letter giving us as complete a report as possible regarding this situation. We would also appreciate your sending us any substantiating documents that may be available pertaining to this matter, such as copy of police report; court records; statement from boys involved or the parents of the boys; any newspaper clippings.

This additional information is most helpful for future reference and identification purposes. Thanks for your kind cooperation.
