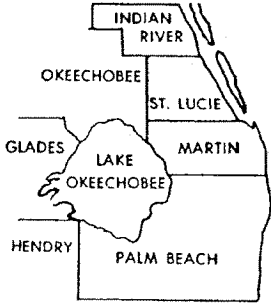


Dear Mr. Krall:
