AN INTERVIEW WITH [REDACTED], THE SCOUT, AND HIS MOTHER

The troop went on an overnight camping trip at a campsite in Oakham, Mass., on April 19 and 20, 1968. On arriving at the campsite the troop set up tents and [REDACTED] was told by the Scoutmaster, Robert Zabek, that he would sleep in his tent. The boy said he didn't want to but was told by the Scoutmaster that there was a lot of fun planned for that night. The boy said he was afraid because Zabek had told obscene stories before, asked the boys what he had in his hands with his hands in his pockets, and having boys strip as part of what he called an "initiation". A campfire was held, and ended about 9:30. The boy then entered Zabek's tent and they both proceeded to get ready to go to bed. Zabek immediately started to tell obscene stories. This began to worry the boy but he was told to keep his "mouth shut". Zabek told him if he opened his mouth or yelled he would tell everyone that the boy was "playing" with all the boys on the street. After convincing the boy to be quiet, the boy got into his sleeping bag. Shortly after, Zabek started to reach into the boy's sleeping bag. The boy tried to stop him but once again was threatened. After deciding that it was useless to fight him, Zabek then played with the boy's genitals for a considerable period of time. This whole procedure lasted about two hours. The next morning while eating breakfast one of the boy's friends asked him how he made out last night and Zabek overheard the remark and pointing at [REDACTED] with a can opener, he told him to keep his mouth shut. The boy later told his friend what happened. While driving home from the camping trip the boy said to his friend "Wait till my mother hears what happened last night," Zabek made no comment. The boy told his mother and brother-in-law the story and they then notified the Scout Chaplain at the Church and the Police Department.

However, although your letter indicates that Zabek has homosexual tendencies, we really need more detailed information. Just what actually happened? What situation or incidents occurred to cause you to place him on the file? We would very much appreciate your writing us a letter giving us the complete story. We would also appreciate your forwarding to us any substantiating documents that may be available pertaining to this matter, such as a statement from the boy involved or the boy's parents.

Enclosed is a confidential record sheet which we ask you to fill out and return to us as soon as possible, together with the above requested information. This will enable us to complete our records and to identify this individual should he ever again attempt to register in the Scouting program. Thanks for your help.

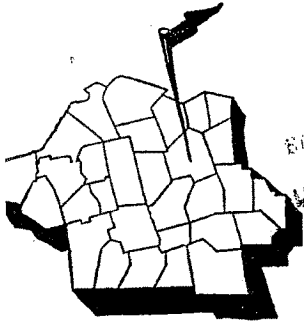
