

Dear Mr. Gleed:

On July 14, 4½ months ago, you sent us a Separation Notice concerning Elmer Goodwin, Scoutmaster of Troop 97, and indicated that he had been arrested on charges of contributing to the delinquency of minors. We responded on July 21 and sent you a confidential record sheet which we asked you to fill out and return, together with supporting information. We wrote you again on August 26 and, again, on September 26 and, again, on November 1, and now it is December 3.

Please won't you take the necessary time to fill out the record sheet and send it to us with a letter giving as much additional information as you have, including possibly newspaper clippings or other supporting material? If you cannot do this, won't you please acknowledge our letters so that we will know that there is a reason you couldn't send us the information? We must have this information -- the completed confidential record sheet and supporting factual material in order to support our position that we are unwilling to accept Mr. Goodwin's registration at some future time. Without this, we have no support and we cannot justify placing him in our files.

We will appreciate your early cooperation.

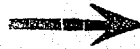
