My son, [Redacted] presently aged 15 and a member of Troop 161, went on a week end camping trip during the summer of 1959. The adult Scouting leader on this trip was a Mr. Robt. Huelsman (registered in Cincinnati phone book as Bob Huelsman.) and the destination for this trip was Camp Powderhorn in northern Kentucky.
