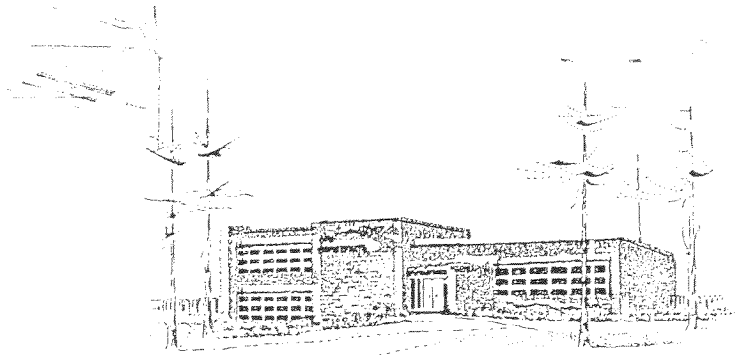

Dear Howard:

Sorry we could not get a written statement about Dr. Robert H. Bruskin. We have a verbal statement from officials at Fort Bragg to the effect that Dr. Bruskin was convicted in a Military Trial of a crime against nature involving a minor. The statement to us is that he has been confined for 30 months, and given a dishonorable discharge.

Mr. Dale Messmer was never actually tried. He was given an undesirable discharge from the army. We do not know his whereabouts. About the most definite thing we have about him is a verbal statement that he made to one of our staff members to the effect that he had made some mistakes and that there was some basis for an investigation to which he was subjected by Military Authority.

S/Sgt. Harry L. Steinhilber was tried and convicted of a crime against nature involving a minor. He was given a dishonorable discharge, a \$10,000 fine, and 10 years confinement.

I do not believe we can now turn up any more information about these men, but if you think there is something else we need to try to do, let us know.

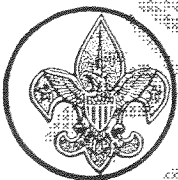
