

Dear Sir:

At your request the following information is respectfully submitted regarding the criminal activity of this subject who has been a leader in Scout Work within the jurisdiction of your Council.

In August 1962 SHILLING was charged with several counts of breaking and entering and larceny along with 3 juveniles in the 14 and 15 year age group. He was charged by Detectives of this department, and was prosecuted in the Circuit Court of Washington County. Prominent persons including the Clergy and also an Attorney testified as character witnesses in his behalf, which resulted in a verdict of probation without verdict by the Circuit Court. At the time of this offense he was engaged in Scout Leadership work with St Mary's Catholic Church.

On June 25th, 1964 our Detective Bureau received a complaint that following a Scout Meeting at Fountaindale School on the evening of June 24th, 1964, that SHILLING attempted to perform an Unnatural and Perverted Sex Act on a 12 year old Scout on the Fountaindale School property. It is to be noted that SHILLING was a leader in Scouts at this time, and the criminal act was in conjunction with his scout duties.

An investigation was made by our department resulting in the arrest and trial of SHILLING in Juvenile Court where he entered a guilty plea. At the time of this writing, sentence is pending after evaluation by a Psychiatrist at Brooklane Hospital.

I strongly suggest that proper steps be taken to prevent SHILLING from further engagement in Scout Work where he would come in contact with young boys.
