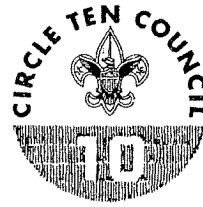

4. When a member dies (please include address of individual).

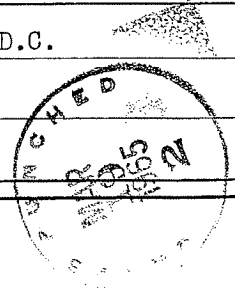
