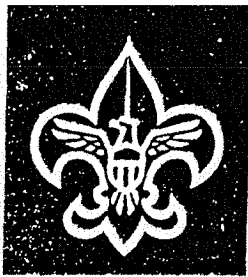

As you can see by the attached letter, we found it necessary to remove from leadership and all active participation in Scouting, Mr. Carl Zemancik, Scoutmaster of Troop 458. I do not believe the parents of the young men involved plan to prosecute so we will be unable to send you information regarding a conviction. I have enclosed two signed statements from Scouts who were involved in the incidents. Mr. Zemancik did not challenge our decision, and I believe he will not attempt to reregister at any future time in Scouting. If you need any further information, please let me know.

By way of follow-up, Ms. Nancy Gill has since been tried and I understand was found guilty of the drug charges as originally indicated. We have been attempting to get a copy of the court record, but have been unable to do so. As soon as this becomes available, I will forward it to you.

Regarding Mr. Larry Piatter, this was only an inquiry on my part, indicative of suspicious behavior. We have been unable to verify any wrong-doing on his part, only suspicions. He has since registered as an Assistant Scoutmaster in Troop 75. We plan to watch his conduct very closely but at this time we have nothing on which to base a suspension or revocation of registration. If anything develops, we will keep you informed.


Dear Mr. Zemancik:

I went on a trip to Florida, (Daytona Beach) with [REDACTED] and Carl Zemanick. We left Christmas Eve December 24, 1978 from Spencer. We got down to Florida and were staying in Trayport Inn Motel. We watch a movie in the room on T.V. and decided to go to bed. I was sleeping in the same bed with Carl Zemanick, because I was youngest. [REDACTED] told me that because I was the youngest I had to sleep with Carl Zemanick. I had been asleep for about an hour or so. Carl would put his arm around me, and with his other hand put it down my underwear, and start rubbing

my dick. This went on every night we were in Florida. (All 7 nights) He had asked me (redacted) not to tell anyone about it. Nothing else happened, and we came home. I [REDACTED] had fallen asleep and was awakened. Carl had his hand in my pants ~~and~~ rubbing my penis. I pushed him away and went back to sleep. This happened 3 or 4 times that night. I woke up before he did the next morning (Sunday) and had gotten dressed when he was waking up. I didn't say anything and went to get breakfast ready. We had breakfast going (French toast) and we burned it, and Mr Jemanick said it would be a big mess to clean up. We finished breakfast and I went to the stream to wash the pan, while he cleaned up camp. We got ready to leave and took the stuff back to the car. He left in the car and I [REDACTED] had to finish my hike. I walked on the trail and got up to the house. He took me home, and left without coming in. I didn't say anything to my mother.
